The purpose of the recreational vehicle parking ordinance is to ensure that recreational vehicles [boats, RVs, trailers, campers], and non-operational vehicles be parked properly in city limits; not on city streets and right-of-ways, nor on public property. This request is for exception to the ordinance, for parking of such vehicles for a period of time in excess of five (5) days in a 30-day period.

The RV must also be parked on the street area within the confines of the requesting RV owners lot that owner resides on. The street area available for parking of the RV shall be defined as the side lot lines being extended in the same bearing and direction of the side lot lines out into the street right of way.
