CALL PUBLIC HEARING TO ORDER

The public hearing was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chair Lambert.

VISITOR COMMENTS

There were no visitor comments.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM MAY 26TH 2010 AND SEPTEMBER 29TH 2010

Commissioner Pam Powell made a motion to approve the minutes from May 26th 2010. Commissioner Anne Parrott seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

Commissioner Parrot made a motion to approve the minutes from September 29th, 2010. Commissioner Kannikar Petersen seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

REVIEW OF SEPTEMBER 2010 FISCAL REPORT

There were no changes and no discussion.

OLD BUSINESS

5 YEAR PLAN REVIEW

Commissioner Parrot and Commissioner Powell have reviewed the 5 Year Plan and have suggestions for updates. They will review the update and report back to the Commission.

FUTURE PROJECTS

Commissioner Petersen talked about the future projects report that she put together. She would

like to add Highway 30 as a focus area for future art projects to make the City look more inviting. She would like to install illuminated art that looks like a gateway. She said that ODOT Road would be willing to work with the Commission and come to a meeting regarding art possibilities. The Commission formed a subcommittee to address the Gateway Project.

ACC ORDINANCE REVIEW

Commissioner Petersen recommended setting a minimum cost of \$750.00 for an art project—approximately five times the cost to hold the public hearing to approve the art—and setting a minimum size of 2' x 2' x 2' before a public hearing must be held to approve art. She said it would save time and money. Commissioner Powell said she would like to change the language from "the Commission is allowed to make a recommendation" to "the Commission may make a recommendation" so that the Commission can have more leeway in holding public hearings. The changes will be forwarded to Chad Olsen, City Administrator, for review.

PUBLIC ART COLLECTION INVENTORY UPDATE

Library Director Jeffries sent out notice to the department heads. City Administrator Olsen has assigned someone at City Hall to do the inventory there. The Police Chief has said there is no art in the Police Station. Library Director Jeffries is doing the inventory at the Library. Dale Goodman, Public Works Director, will do the Public Works inventory, and Chair Lambert will inventory all art commissioned by the Arts & Cultural Commission.

13TH ST & COLUMBIA BLVD ISLAND STUDY UPDATE

The City is studying the island in conjunction with the TSP update on November 4th. Per the municipal code, Commissioner Petersen said that anything in the restrictive zone on the island has to be under 3 feet tall or over 8 feet tall. In the other areas on the island, you can put tall landscaping. Mayor Randy Peterson said that there are people on staff that can evaluate visual clearance issues.

BANNER UPDATE

Aluminum has been obtained and Chair Lambert is in contact with the artists. A date needs to be decided for when the art is due. Commissioner Parrott said the end of March would be a good date to set the completion time. Commissioner Petersen talked to Sue Nelson, Civil Engineer Supervisor, and the permit has been approved by the City. A historic pole needs to be installed for the banner by The Vault.

NEW BUSINESS

COLUMBIA COUNTY RIDER-JANET WRIGHT

Janet Wright told the Commission that there are new drawings of the transit center on the Rider website. They would like to have colorful bike racks and benches installed. Commissioner Petersen suggested having high school students manufacture the bike racks. She also suggested stationary trash cans be installed with art, such as mosaics, incorporated into the design. Margaret Jeffries, Library Director, said she has contacted Lisa Scholl to see if the City has a contract or agreement for locating artwork on private property. Janet Wright said she was interested in inserting colored tiles into the concrete sidewalks. Commissioner Powell and Commissioner Petersen will work with Janet Wright regarding potential art projects.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, December 8th at 6:30 p.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.

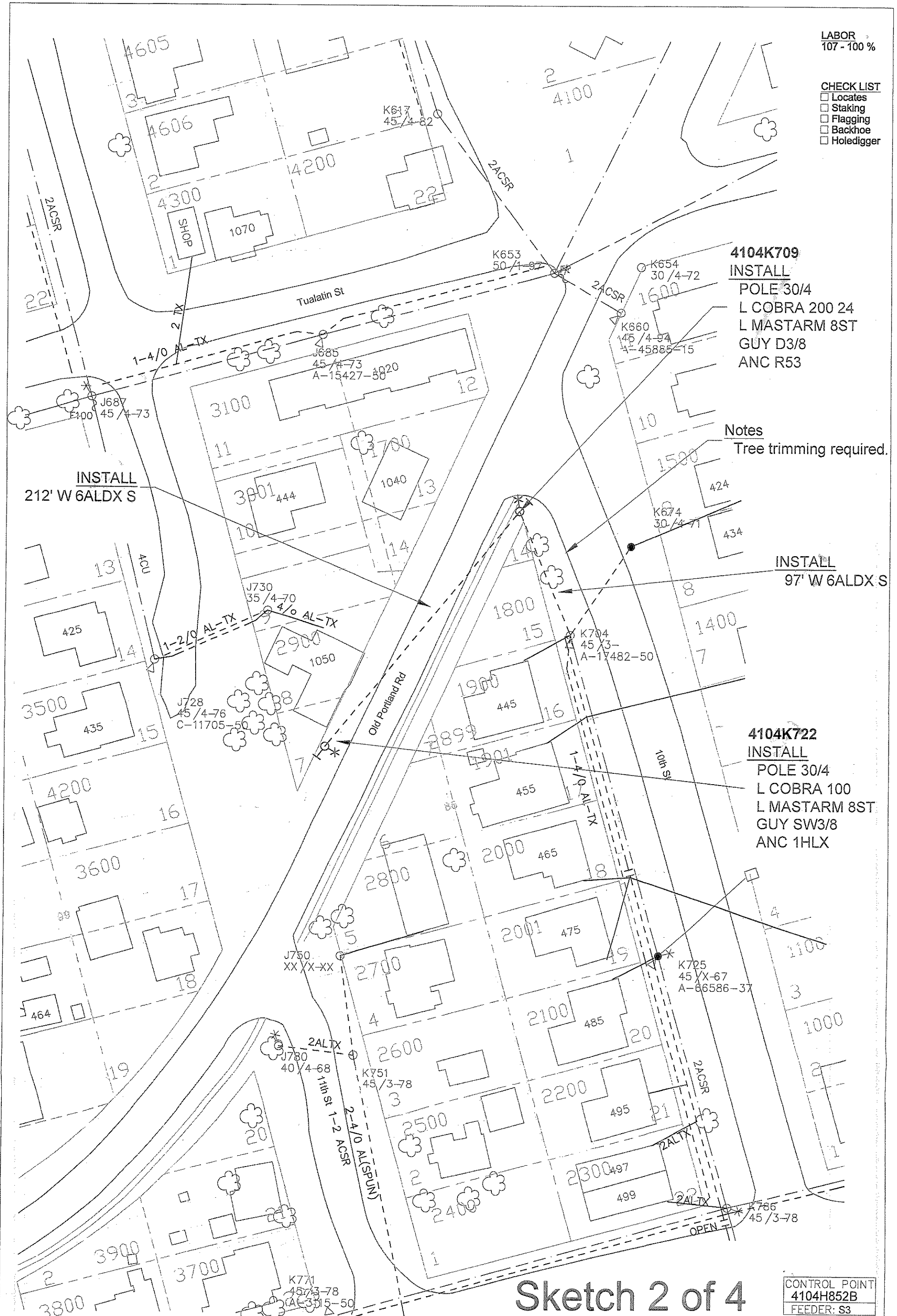

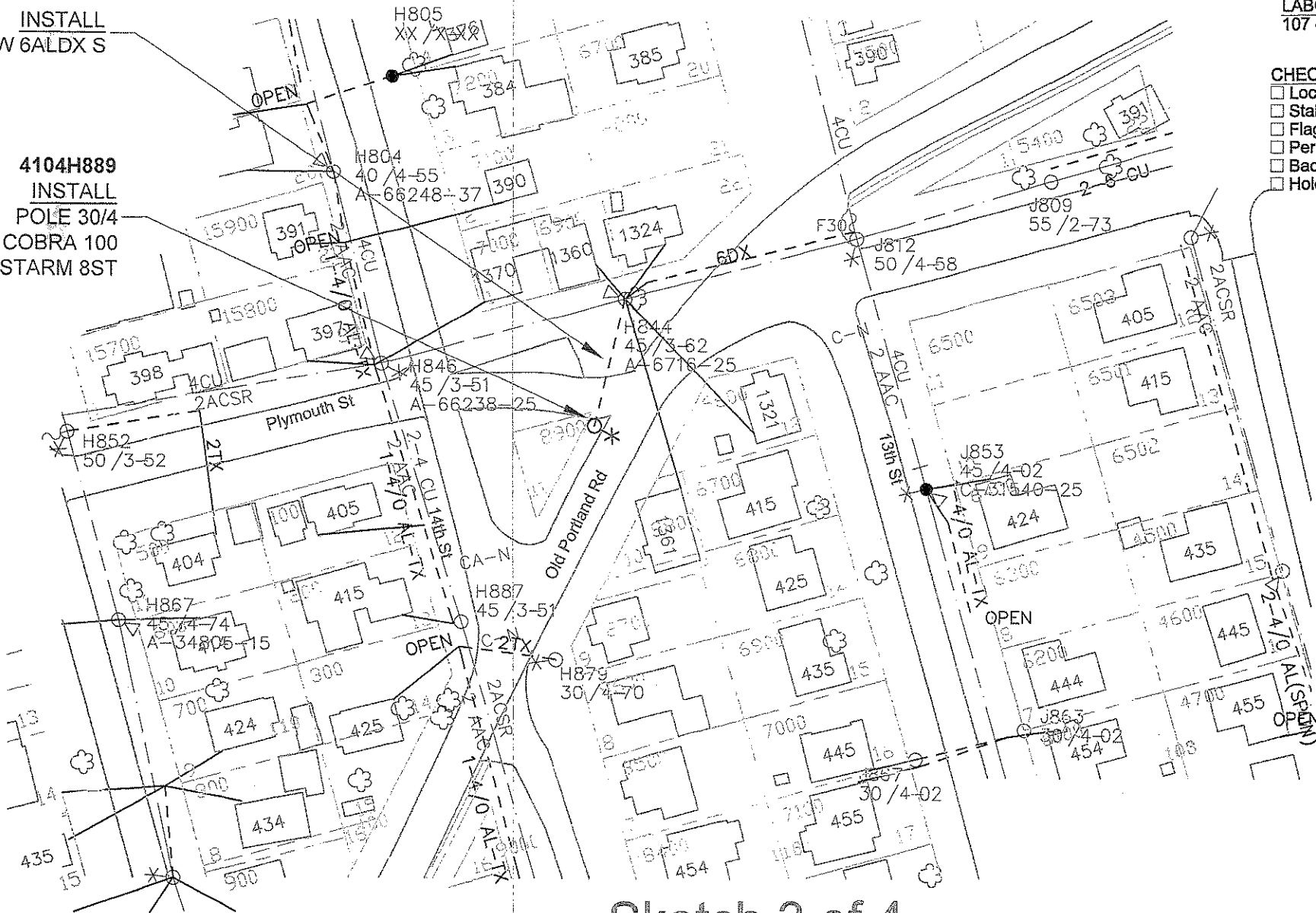
