



**St. Helens Municipal Court
Fine Amnesty Program**



If you have unpaid fines in the St. Helens Municipal Court that have resulted in the suspension of your driving privileges and/or have been referred to a collection agency, there is a short term Amnesty Program available that may help you.

**This program runs from February 1, 2012
through April 13, 2012.**

**LIMITED
TIME ONLY**

**All qualifying accounts will be eligible
for up to a 25% discount if paid in full.**

What should you do if you think you may qualify for this program?

- Check with the court to determine eligibility and the amount owing.

- Check with the DMV to determine what will be required of you to obtain a valid license.

- Check with other courts that have outstanding fines against you.

Once your outstanding fines have been paid, you will be given clearance forms to take to the DMV. These forms will show the DMV that you have met the court's requirements and the hold against your license will be lifted. Your license is NOT automatically reinstated with the payment of your fines. Be sure to complete the necessary requirements with the DMV to obtain your valid license.
